Applications are invited online only from qualified candidates for Selection to the under mentioned post in Kerala Government Service. Applications must be submitted online only through the official website of the Kerala Public Service Commission ([www.keralapsc.gov.in](http://www.keralapsc.gov.in)) after 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION'. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile. Candidates who have aadhaar card should add the same as ID proof in their profile.

1. **Department** : **Kerala Police**
2. **Name of Post** : **Woman Police Constable (Women Police Battalion)**
3. **Scale of Pay** : **₹ 31,100 - 66,800/-**
4. **Number of vacancies** : **Anticipated Vacancies**

**Note:**

- (i) Differently abled candidates and male candidates are not eligible to apply for this post.
- (ii) The recruitment to the post of Woman Police Constable will only be to the Woman Police Battalion and the vacancies occurring in the district will be filled up by transferring the officers on the basis of Advice/Rank Seniority. (GO(Rt)No. 1484/2017/Home dated 05.06.2017).
- (iii) The name, educational qualification and age for this post notified as per G.O (MS) 203/86/Home dtd. 11.09.1986 (SRO No. 1387/86) and G.O (P) No. 139/2017/Home Dtd. 08.12.2017 (SRO No. 788/2017).
- (iv) The Ranked list published shall cease to be in force after one year from the date of finalization of the ranked list. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancies that may be reported to the Commission in writing during the period of currency of the ranked list.

5. **Method of appointment** : **Direct Recruitment (Statewide)**
6. **Age limit** : **18-26.** Candidates born between 02.01.1999 and 01.01.2007 (both dates included) only are eligible to apply for this post.

**Note:-**Maximum age limit shall be relaxed upto 29 years for candidates belonging to other backward communities and 31 years for SC/ST candidates. [For other conditions regarding age relaxation, please see para 2(i) of the General Conditions.] Other conditions regarding age relaxation in Para (2) of the General Conditions are not applicable to this selection.

**7. Qualification:-**

- (a) **Educational Qualifications:** Pass in Higher Secondary (Plus Two) Examination or its equivalent.

**Note:** i) In the case of SC and ST candidates who have failed in the Higher Secondary (Plus Two) examination shall also be considered if sufficient number of qualified candidates not available to fill up the Quota reserved for SC and ST.

ii) Rule 10 (a) (ii) of Part II of the KS&SSR is applicable.

iii) In addition to the qualification specified in the Notification, the qualification declared by Government through executive orders or standing orders, as equivalent to the prescribed educational qualification and the higher qualifications of the notified and

prescribed basic qualifications shall be accepted. The Government Order regarding the equivalent qualification/higher qualification shall be produced as and when called for by the Commission.

(b) **Physical qualifications**

(i) **Height** : A minimum of 157 cm.

**Note:** Minimum Height measurement shall be 150 cm for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe communities

(ii) **Eye sight** : Must be certified to possess the visual standards specified below without glasses.

	<b>Vision</b>	<b>Right Eye</b>	<b>Left Eye</b>
(a)	Distant Vision	6/6 Snellen	6/6 Snellen
(b)	Near Vision	0.5 Snellen	0.5 Snellen

**Note:**

- (i) Each eye must have a full field of vision.
- (ii) Colour blindness, squint or any morbid conditions of the eye or lids of either eye shall be a disqualification.
- (iii) Must be free from apparent physical defects like knock-knee, flat foot, varicose vein, deformed limbs, irregular and protruding tooth, defective speech and hearing.

(c) **Physical Efficiency Test**

Must qualify in any **5 (five)** events out of **8 (eight)** events specified below of the National Physical Efficiency, (One Star Standard Test).

1.	100 Metres Run	17 Seconds
2.	High Jump	1.06 metres
3.	Long Jump	3.05 metres
4.	Putting the Shot (4 kg)	4.88 metres

6.	Throwing the throw ball	14 metres
7.	Shuttle Race ( 25x 4 metres)	26 seconds
8.	Skipping (one minute)	80 times

**Note:-**

1. The Physical measurement of candidates will be taken at the time of physical efficiency test and those who do not possess the prescribed physical measurement will not be admitted for the physical efficiency test. **If accidents or injuries happen to a candidate while participating in the physical efficiency test, she will not be given further chance to participate in the test.**
2. The tentative schedule for Physical Measurement and Physical Efficiency test will be published in the official website of Kerala Public Service Commission.

If the specifications are not as indicated above, the officer issuing the Certificate should certify whether the candidate has got better standards of vision or worse standards of vision as the case may be, otherwise the Certificate will not be accepted.

**8. Mode of submitting applications:**

(a) Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission ([www.keralapsc.gov.in](http://www.keralapsc.gov.in)) before applying for the post. Candidates who have already registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the '**Apply Now**' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. Those candidates who create new profile should upload their photograph taken within six months. Name of the candidate and the date of taking photograph should be printed at the bottom portion of the photograph. The photograph once uploaded meeting all the requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. **Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link 'Applications' in their profile. All correspondences with the Commission, regarding the application should be accompanied with the printout of the application.** Candidates are responsible for the correctness of their personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application, candidates must ensure the correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application once submitted is received as provisional and the details cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The application submitted not in accordance with the conditions stipulated in the notification will be summarily rejected in due course of processing. Documents to prove qualification, Experience, Community, age etc have to be produced as and when called for.

(b) If Written/OMR/Online Test is conducted as part of the selection, candidates shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time registration profile. Such candidates alone can generate and download the Admission Tickets in the last 15 days before the date of test. The applications of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period, will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of admission tickets will be published in the examination calendar itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobile phone number registered in it.

**9. Last date for submission of applications : 14.01.2026 Wednesday up to 12 Midnight.**

**10.** Candidates having 'A', 'B' & 'C' certificate of NCC will be given weightage marks at the rate of 2%, 3% and 5% respectively, vide G.O (Ms) No.112/2007/HEdn. Dated 21.08.2007.

**11.** Extra marks will be awarded to meritorious sports persons as per para 6 of the general conditions.

**12.** Student Police Cadet (SPC) Certificate holders will be given weightage marks as per G.O.(MS) No.06/2025/P&RD dated 01.03.2025.

**13. Special Instructions to candidates :**

(i) In the case of difference in Caste/Community claimed in the application and that entered in SSLC Book, the candidate shall produce a gazette notification in this regard, along with Non-Creamy Layer Certificate / Community Certificate at the time of certificate verification.

(ii) Candidates are required to acquaint themselves with the instructions given in the notification as Part II, General Conditions before submitting application for the post. Applications which are not submitted in accordance with the terms and conditions laid down in the General conditions are liable to be rejected.

(iii) Appropriate disciplinary actions as per rule 22 of the Kerala Public Service Commission

Rules of procedure shall be initiated against those candidates who submit applications with bogus claims of qualification regarding education, experience etc. and are liable to be disqualified for being considered for a particular post or debarment from applying to the Commission either permanently or for any period or the invalidation of their answer scripts or products in a written/practical test or the initiation of criminal or other proceedings against them or their removal or dismissal from office or the ordering of any other disciplinary action against them if they have already been appointed, or any one or more of the above.
