## COMPLETE EXAM DETAILS

### SSC MTS Exam – Scheme of Examination

Aspirants who are applying for the post of SSC MTS Exam – Multi Tasking Staff & Havaldar has different scheme of examination.

#### SSC MTS Exam – For the Post of MTS

Only Computer Based Examination (Tier – I)

#### SSC MTS Exam – For the Post of Havaldar

1. Computer Based Examination (CBE) (Tier- I)
2. Physical Efficiency Test (PET) / Physical Standard Test (PST)

The Computer Based Examination will be conducted in Hindi, English and in 13 regional languages viz.

### SSC MTS Exam 2025 – Exam Pattern

The Exam Pattern for the Computer Based Test – Tier I Exam of the SSC MTS Exam 2025 will be conducted in 2 Sessions.

Session-I	I	Numerical and Mathematical Ability	20 / 60	45 Minutes (60 Minutes for candidates eligible for scribes as per para 8)
	II	Reasoning Ability and Problem Solving	20 / 60	
Session-II	I	General Awareness	25 / 75	45 Minutes (60 Minutes for candidates eligible for scribes as per para 8)

#### Session-I Duration:

Candidates will get 45 minutes to complete Session-I. After 45 minutes, Session-I will automatically close.

#### Session-II Commencement:

Immediately after Session-I ends, Session-II will begin.

It will also be of 45 minutes duration.

At the end of Session-II, the Computer Based Examination will conclude.

#### Type of Questions:

The exam will consist of Objective Type, Multiple Choice Questions.

**Language of Questions:**

- **Session-I** and the **General Awareness section of Session-II** will be available in:
  - **English**
  - **Hindi**
  - **13 regional languages** (as per para 14.2).

**Negative Marking Policy:**

- **No negative marking** in **Session-I**.
- In **Session-II**, **1 mark will be deducted for each wrong answer**.
- Candidates should answer carefully keeping this in mind.

## **SSC MTS Exam – Physical Efficiency Test (PET) / Physical Standard Test (PST)**

The Physical Efficiency Test in the SSC MTS Exam will be conducted only for the post of Havaldar in CBIC and CBN.

**Physical Test – Male Candidates**

- Must walk **1600 meters** in **15 minutes**.

**Physical Test – Female Candidates**

- Must walk **1 kilometer (1000 meters)** in **20 minutes**.

**Physical Standard Test (PST):**The minimum physical standards for the post of Havaldar in CBIC and CBN are as follows:

**Male Candidates (14.7.3.1)**

- **Height:**
  - Minimum: **157.5 cms**
  - **Relaxable by 5 cms** for:
    - Garhwalis
    - Assamese
    - Gorkhas

- Members of Scheduled Tribes
- **Chest:**
  - Minimum: **81 cms** (fully expanded)
  - **Minimum expansion: 5 cms**

### **Female Candidates (14.7.3.2)**

- **Height:**
  - Minimum: **152 cms**
  - **Relaxable by 2.5 cms** for:
    - Garhwalis
    - Assamese
    - Gorkhas
    - Members of Scheduled Tribes
- **Weight:**
  - Minimum: **48 kg**
  - **Relaxable by 2 kg** for:
    - Garhwalis
    - Assamese
    - Gorkhas

## **SSC MTS – Age Limit**

The minimum age limit to apply for the SSC MTS Recruitment is 18 years and the maximum age limit to apply for the SSC MTS Recruitment is 25 Years for the post of SSC MTS. And the maximum age is 27 years for the Post of Havaldar.

For the Post of MTS

**Maximum Age – 25 Years**

**Minimum Age – 18 Years**

i.e. candidates born not before 02.08.2000 and not later than 01.08.2007) for MTS.

For the Post of Havaldar

**Maximum Age : 27 Years**

**Minimum Age : 18 Years**

i.e. candidates born not before 02.08.1998 and not later than 01.08.2007) for Havaldar in CBIC and CBN, Department of Revenue and a few posts of MTS in various departments.

## SSC CHSL Exam : Selection Process

The SSC CHSL Exam Selection Process includes **two Computer-Based Exams** namely:

- **SSC CHSL Tier I Exam**
- **SSC CHSL Tier II Exam**

The SSC CHSL Tier I Exam will be a computer-based online examination. It consists of 4 parts with objective type MCQs only. It will consist of 100 questions for 200 marks. The duration of the SSC CHSL Tier I Exam will be 60 minutes.

SSC CHSL Tier II Exam 2025 will be conducted in two sessions: Session I and Session II. Session I will consist of Section I with Mathematical Abilities, Reasoning and General Intelligence, Section II with English Language and Comprehension, General Awareness and Section II with Computer Knowledge Test.

Session II will consist of Section IV with Skill Test / Typing Test. The duration of Session I will be 2 hours and 15 minutes.

The questions in SSC CHSL Tier I Exam will be in English, Hindi or any language opted by the candidate in the SSC CHSL application form. There will be a **negative marking of 0.50 marks** for each wrong answers.

## SSC CHSL Exam : Age Limit

- The **minimum** age to apply for the SSC CHSL Exam is 18 years.
- The maximum age limit for the SSC CHSL Exam is 27 years.

#### SSC CGL Exam Pattern Pattern for Tier 1

The SSC CGL exam pattern/scheme is determined by the Staff Selection commission (SSC) and published on the official website. All revisions and changes in the pattern are also conveyed to the candidates through the website.

The **tier 1 examination contains multiple-choice, objective-type questions**. All questions in the examination, except the English Comprehension, are in English and Hindi both.

- For every incorrect answer, there is a negative marking/penalty of **0.5marks**.

#### SSC CGL Selection Process for Tier II

According to the latest SSC CGL 2023 Recruitment notification, SSC CGL Tier 2 will consist of 3 Papers. **Paper 1 will be compulsory for all candidates**, irrespective of the posts they are applying for. While **SSC CGL Tier 2 is mandatory for JSO posts**, and **Paper 3 is for Assistant Audit Officer/ Assistant Accounts Officer**.
